1 Day Course On Blocks

The aim of this course is to teach the delegate everything there is to know about AutoCAD blocks.

Over the years the way in which blocks are used and managed has changed greatly. For instance most people do not make proper use of Tool palettes despite them being around since 2004.

We will teach you how to create, use, edit and manage blocks in surprisingly many different ways. We will also show you how to create and use dynamic blocks as well as advanced features such as attributes that allow you to add specific information about a block that can be used within the drawing or exported to an AutoCAD table or Microsoft Excel
